The Floyd County Conservation Board has started a fund-raising campaign for a major capital improvement project at the Tosanak Recreation Area located near Marble Rock, Iowa.

Floyd County is one of only three counties in NE Iowa that offers cabin rentals in their county parks. This project is to build a four season modern family sized cabin. The cabin will enhance our ability to accommodate families year round. It will increase use of and showcase the uniqueness of the Tosanak Recreation Area.

The cabin will contain:

- 3 bedrooms
- 2 baths
- 1100 square feet
- Handicap accessible

The cabin would be located on a ridge overlooking the Shell Rock River.
